You will need to swipe your valid CUNY Card with photo ID or scan your Lehman 360 Digital ID to enter the Center. Accounts and Online Services

Lehman staff and faculty receive two separate and distinct computer accounts shortly after they begin their employment at the College:

- Lehman Username
- CUNYfirst

Each account is composed of an identifier unique to the owner, referred to as a *userid* or *username*, and a *password* that secures access to the account. Account holders are expected to be familiar with the management of the accounts and with the services the accounts provide.

Your Lehman username and password

Your Lehman username provides access to many Lehman online services including:

- The campus-wide wireless network for use with your mobile devices
- Remote access to Lehman Library online materials from off campus
- Lehman College Digital Connect (LCDC) to access audio and video files.
- Lehman One Access for "reduced sign-on"
- Printing on campus
- Lehman 360

Your Lehman username is usually composed of your first name and last name separated by a period (*firstname.lastname*) with all special characters such as spaces, apostrophes and hyphens removed. For example, Jane Smith's username is likely to be **jane.smith**. Your Lehman username is **not** case-sensitive. In some cases, a username may have a numeric suffix (e.g., *firstname.lastname2*) if a staff member with the same name already exists in the system. If someone with Jane's name is already in the system, her username might be **jane.smith1**. The password on a new account is composed of your first initial in UPPER CASE, followed by your last initial in UPPER CASE, followed by the first six digits of your social security number. Before using your Lehman username and password for the first time, visit the Lehman Password Manager site at <https://www.lehman.edu/sspm> to register your account and update the password. Lehman Connect Data Migrated to Microsoft Office 365 SharePoint

Lehman Connect documents were migrated to MS Office 365 SharePoint Cloud. The advantages are:

- A self-service platform available 24/7, mobile friendly and accessible using your CUNY login credentials.
- A more user-friendly interface with enhanced functionalities
- Improved performance for faster access to your documents

Exchange Email

You can login to Lehman email with your CUNY Login username and associated password through the Login menu or by going directly to Exchange webmail at <https://www.lehman.edu/logins/>. Your Lehman email address is your username followed by “@lehman.cuny.edu.” For example, Jane Smith’s email address would be jane.smith10@login.cuny.edu. CUNYfirst

CUNYfirst is CUNY’s web-based, administrative services system. To use CUNYfirst you must activate or “claim” your CUNYfirst account by visiting <https://home.cunyfirst.cuny.edu> and selecting the **New User** link. (You can also reach CUNYfirst by selecting CUNYfirst Login from the Login menu on the Lehman Home Page.) For further information on this process and on managing this account, visit <http://www.lehman.edu/cunyfirst>.

At the completion of the activation process, you will have a CUNYfirst userid composed of your first name and last name separated by a period and followed by a two-digit number and a password that you create. You will also receive an eight-digit ID number referred to as an EMPLID (pronounced “emple id”). The last two digits of the EMPLID are the two digits at the end of your CUNYfirst userid. For example, Jane Smith’s CUNYfirst userid might look like **Jane.Smith22** and her EMPLID might be **10843422**. Once you claim your account, you can login to CUNYfirst at <https://home.cunyfirst.cuny.edu> to access services such as the Faculty Center to view your class schedule, verify student attendance and enter grades.

CUNYfirst sends notifications, including reminders that your CUNYfirst password is about to expire, to your Lehman email account.

If you find that you do not have access to all the CUNYfirst features that you need for your work, you may need to submit a CUNYfirst Security Access Form to have your profile modified. Please email cunyfirst.help@lehman.cuny.edu for assistance.

If you activated your CUNYfirst userid at another CUNY campus that is using CUNYfirst (most are by now), you will continue to use the same userid, password and EMPLID at Lehman.

Lehman College Mobile App

Lehman introduced Lehman College App – an app for your mobile devices. The app may be downloaded from the App Store on iTunes (for IOS devices such as the iPhone) and from Google Play Store (for Android devices) at no charge. Search for "Lehman College" to find the app.

Lehman One Access

Once you are familiar with the Lehman systems, you can simplify login by setting up your "password wallet" on Lehman One Access. Lehman One Access allows you to access individual applications such as Blackboard and CUNYfirst using Lehman credentials. Select Lehman One Access from the login menu on the Lehman home page.

Multifactor Authentication (MFA) and VPN

Multifactor Authentication, also known as MFA, is a tool to minimize attacks that attempt to steal log-in credentials and has become a standard in most organizations. MFA adds an extra security layer to Microsoft Office 365 by requiring a verification code to authorize account access via an app or by text message to your phone. MFA is enabled for MS 365, including your Lehman email, MS Word, Excel, Teams, PowerPoint, etc. MFA is enabled for your departmental functional e-mail account and your individual Lehman email account. You will need to configure MFA first from the Microsoft Office 365 Outlook app.

There are two methods for enabling MFA:

Mobile Device: You can set up MFA to send verification codes to your mobile phone.

Microsoft Authentication App: You can use the Microsoft Authentication App to generate verification codes. Please note that this is a better form when traveling overseas since it will still allow you to receive verification codes using your mobile device via WIFI.

As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance cybersecurity at Lehman College, the Division of Information Technology, in collaboration with CUNY CIS, has been diligently working on implementing critical security measures. We are pleased to announce a significant step in this journey: the implementation of Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) for remote access to the Lehman College network.
