As promised, the Lehman College Student Health Center is continuing its effort to keep our community informed with these latest updates about H1N1 and Seasonal Influenza.

Hand Sanitizers: To encourage regular hand cleansing to reduce the spread of flu virus, approximately 60 hand sanitizer stands have been placed in buildings across campus.

H1N1 vaccine, when available, **will not** be offered at the Student Health Center. If you are a person with high priority to be vaccinated, please contact your physician or you can use this link to locate the designated immunization clinics throughout the city

Seasonal flu vaccine will be offered at the Student Health Center, however, in limited supply. The expected arrival for the vaccine is predicted for late October. Please check your Lehman email or the web for this announcement. Vaccine is free for students with a validated ID.

Self-reporting/Surveillance: Students who become sick with an Influenza-like Illness (ILI) should voluntarily report their absence to the Student Health Center via email at shcquest@lehman.cuny.edu. This is a confidential email address which can only be accessed by the Director. This will allow the college to gauge the approximate amount of absenteeism during the flu season. **It is the student's responsibility, however, to contact professor directly if he or she is unable to attend class.**
