The Student Health Center has been receiving numerous inquiries about the availability of the seasonal flu vaccine at the health center.

CUNY Central Office has reported that students' flu vaccine will be delayed through the **end of November**. If you require this immunization because of a high priority health need, please consult with your physician. If you are a **staff or faculty member**, you may seek the vaccine through your physician or retail pharmacies.

The H1N1 vaccine will **not** be offered by the Student Health Center. Please check the above web site or with your physician for availability.

**Reminder:**

**Self-reporting/Surveillance:** Students who become sick with an Influenza-like Illness (ILI) should voluntarily report their absence to the Student Health Center via email at [shcquest@lehman.cuny.edu](mailto:shcquest@lehman.cuny.edu).

This is a confidential email address which can only be accessed by the Director. This will allow the College to gauge the approximate amount of absenteeism during the flu season.

**Please note: It is the student's responsibility, however, to contact professors directly if he or she is unable to attend class.**

Flu vaccine supplies are limited everywhere. Try to obtain the vaccine in a timely manner to avoid missing out on the opportunity to protect yourself and your loved ones during this flu season.
