DEPARTMENTAL GRADING POLICY
(Effective Fall 2008)

The following grading policy applies in all HIN and NUR courses and should be added to the course syllabus.

A grade of C (73) or better is required in each HIN and NUR course to progress to the next course. If a student earns below a C grade, the course must be repeated in order to be eligible for admission to the nursing program or to continue in the program.

The College grade symbols and corresponding numerical grades are:

F = 59 AND BELOW	

If a student achieves a grade below 73 the grade recorded will be an F. This policy applies to all students enrolled in HIN or NUR courses regardless of the student's major.
