- 34.1% Hispanics (largest ethnic group)

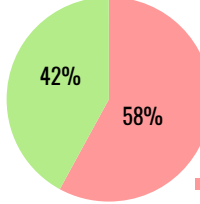

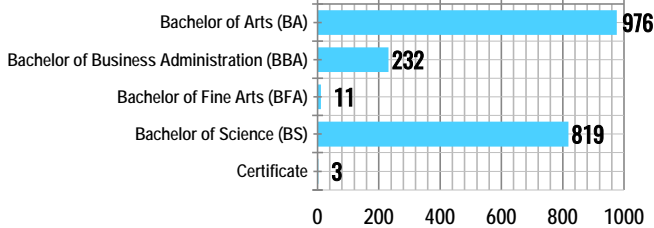

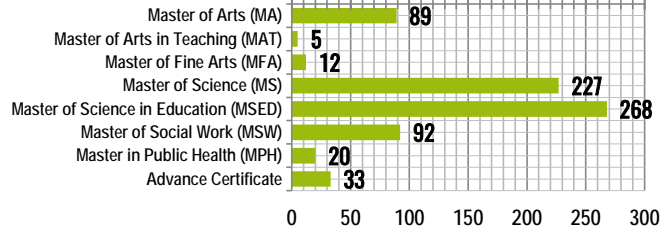


2014-2015 DEGREES AWARDED

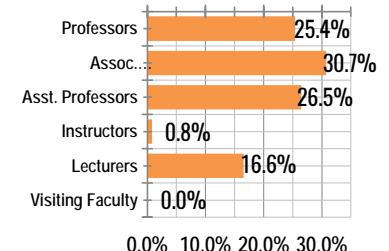

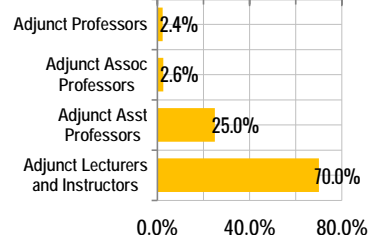
