

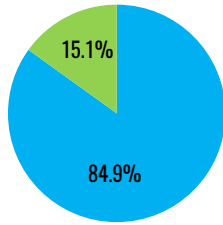

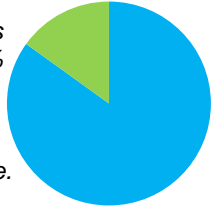

Undergraduates comprise 84.9% of all enrolled students at Lehman College.



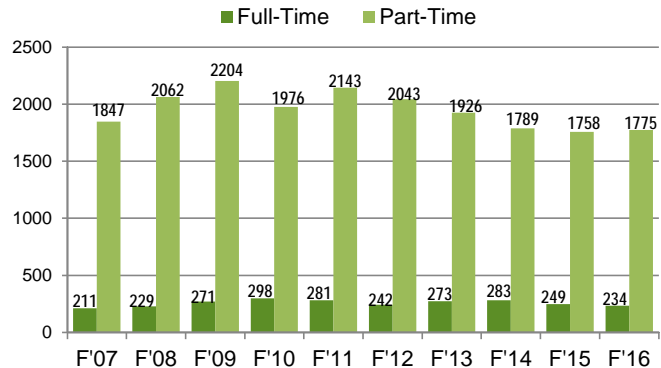
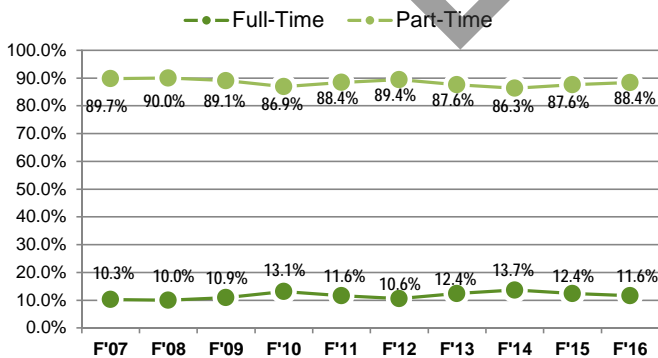
42% of Undergraduate students are pursuing part-time studies compared to almost 88% of Graduate students studying part-time.
