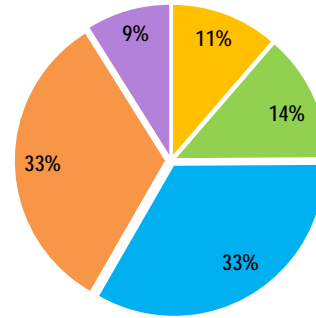

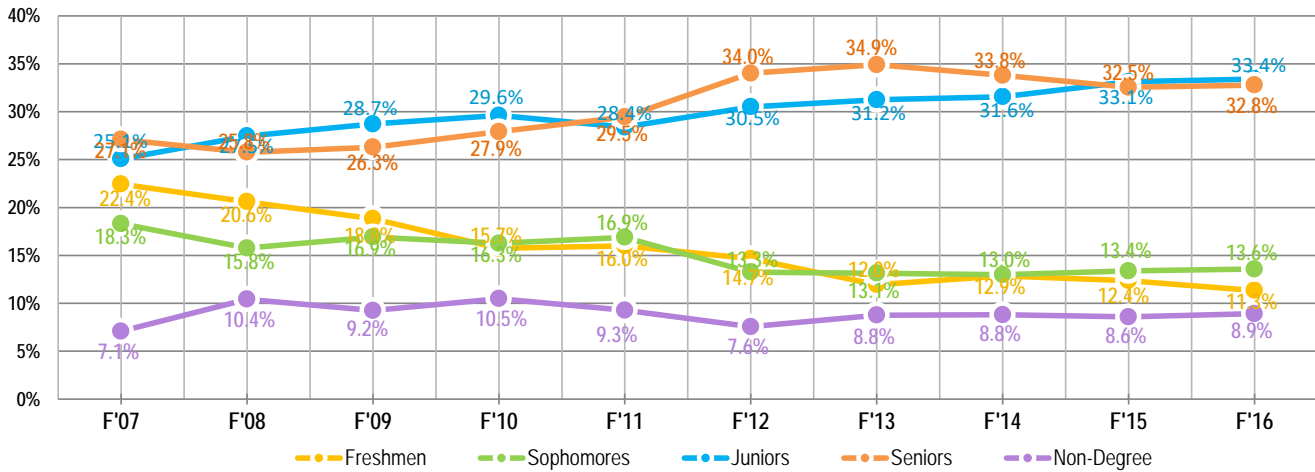


Fall 2016 - Undergraduate Student Classification

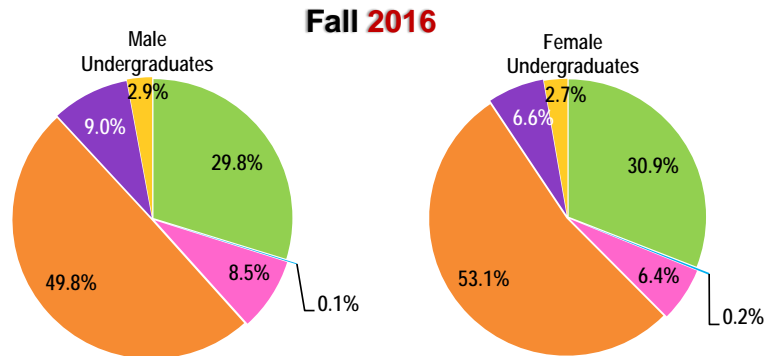

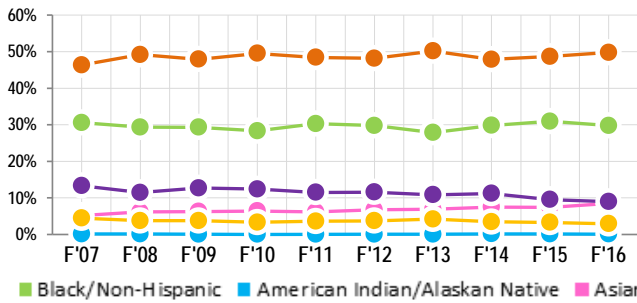

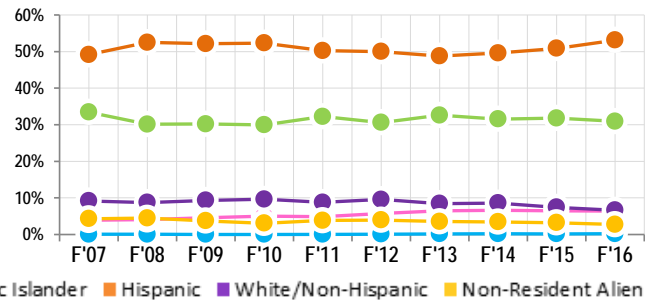

Undergraduate Females by Race & Ethnicity



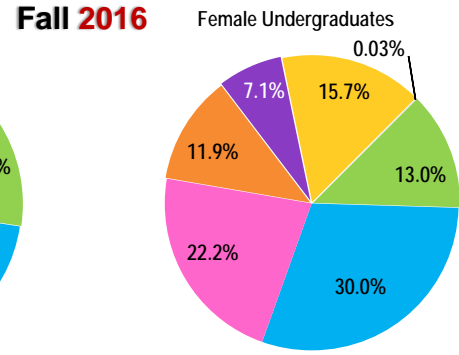
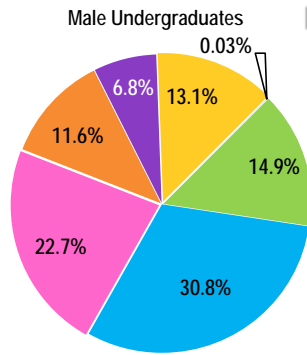

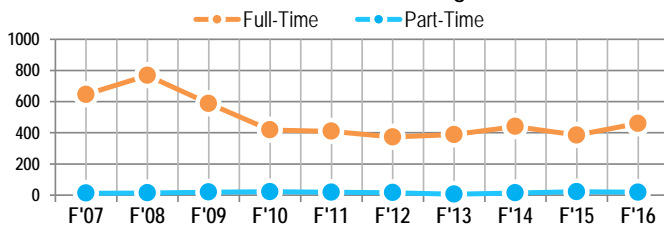
### First-Time Freshmen by Enrollment Status



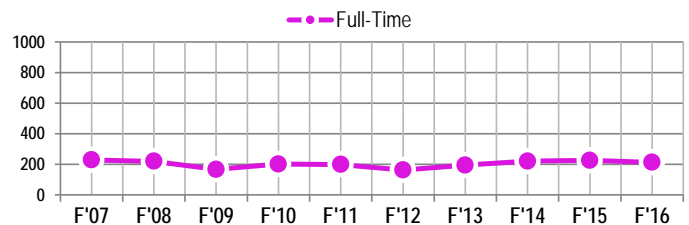

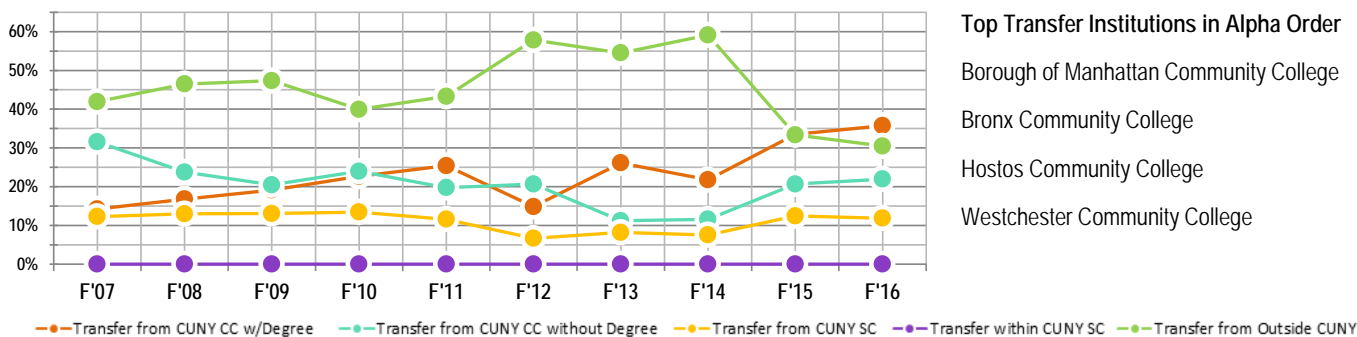

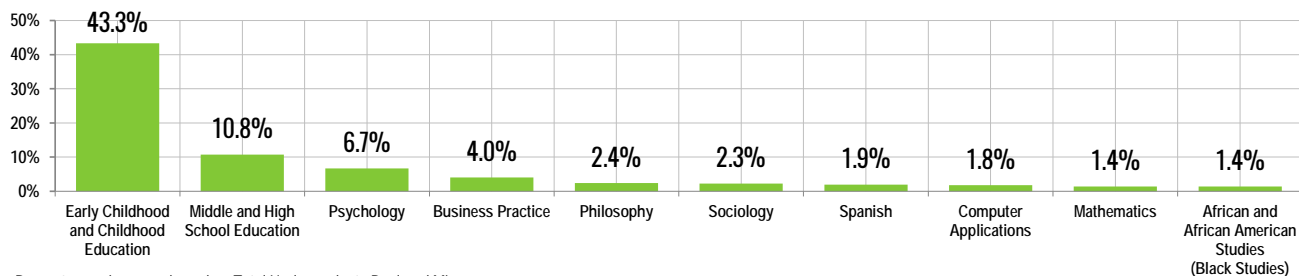

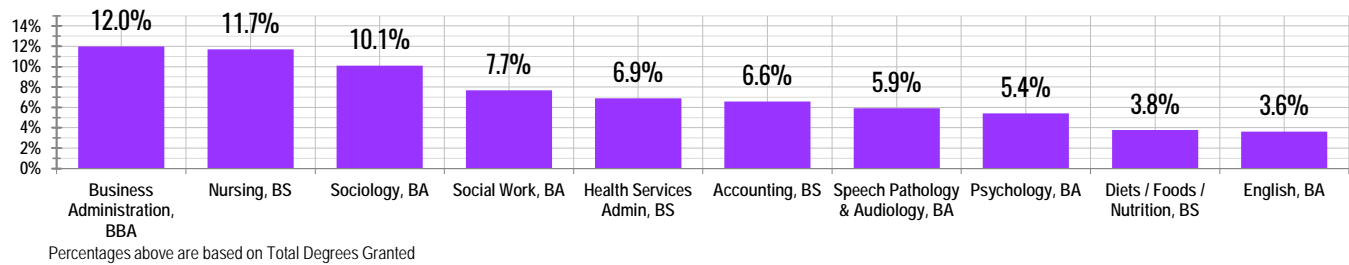

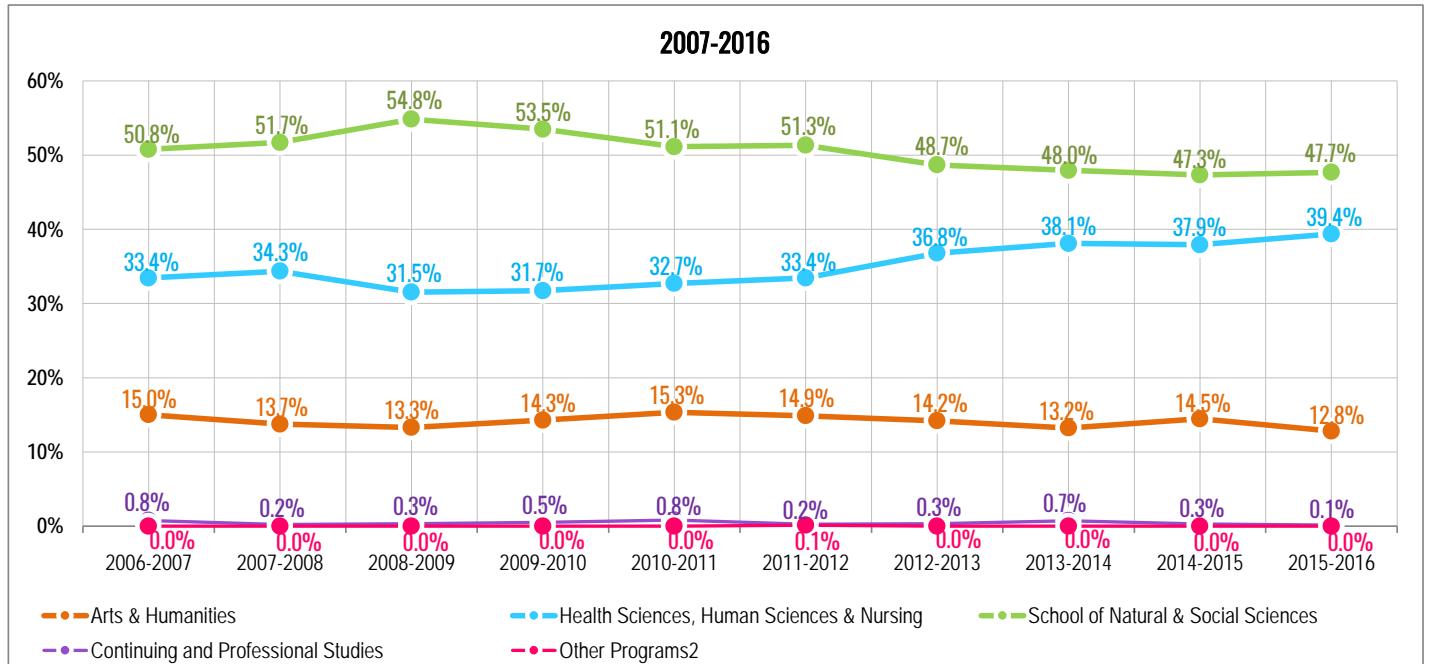
