

## Configuration for Windows 7

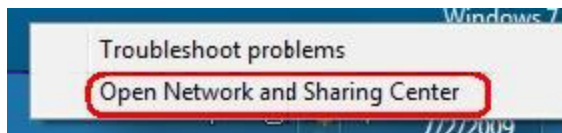
The Lehman College Wireless network broadcasts the SSID (Service Set Identifier), upon launching your web browser; most of the wireless enabled devices will be associated to the Lehman wireless network automatically. Access to the Lehman's wireless networks will require all authorized users in all areas to authenticate to the wireless network using their assigned Lehman's LDAP Account username and password. Only authenticated access to the Lehman wireless network is permitted.

For the first time wireless network users, please follow the steps to add the Lehman wireless network connection to your Windows 7 computer.

- Go to **Start**, click **Control Panel** or
- Right click the wireless icon in the lower right side of the task bar.



- Click **Open Network and Sharing Center**.



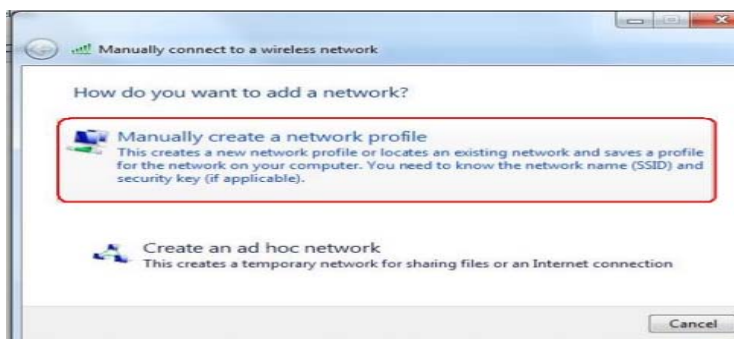
- Click **Manage wireless networks**.



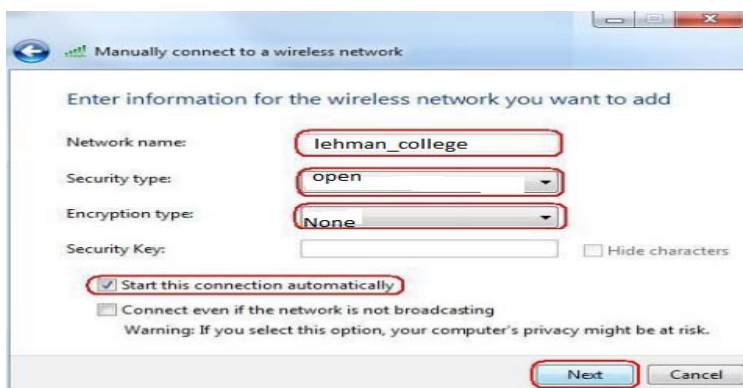
- Click **Add**



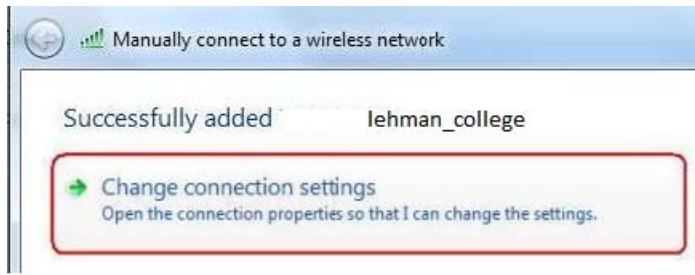
- Click **Manually create a network profile.**



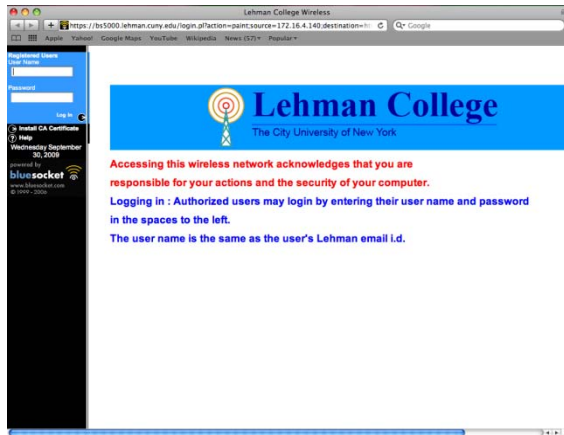
- Specify **lehman\_college** for the network name, **Open** for the security type, **None** for the encryption type.
- Verify that **Start this connection automatically** is checked.
- Click **Next**.



- Click **Change Connection settings.**



- Open a web browser such as Internet Explorer 8 or Firefox



- The browser will be redirected to the Lehman wireless login page
- Enter your Lehman's LDAP username and password
- Click "Login"
- Your Windows 7 computer is now ready to use the Lehman wireless network.
