First - we would like to remind you that many of the Library's books and journals are available electronically and are accessible off campus. Instructions on how to access these resources are included in our remote resources guide and our mobile apps guide.

All CUNY Libraries have suspended regular overdue fines - as well as overdue fines for recalled materials. Also - all CUNY Libraries now allow at least nine renewals of circulating items and will automatically renew items checked out to you. Additionally - Interlibrary Loan staff will automatically request renewals of ILL items on your behalf.
