NSSE, which is a survey given to all first and final year undergraduate students, has been operating from the Indiana University Bloomington School of Education since 1998. The survey measures level of academic challenge, active and collaborative learning, educational experiences, campus climate, student-faculty-interaction, and many other important topics.

Our students' views are especially important to us as we strive to improve the quality of their overall experience by enhancing teaching, learning, and advising. The data we gather from participating in NSSE will help us do so only if we have broad participation. Therefore, I would ask you to encourage your first and final year students to participate in the study. It is very easy to complete. The Office of Institutional Research, Planning, and Assessment has prepared the attached infographic, which contains talking points related to NSSE.
