Launch of Phase II of the Electronic Record Modification Request (e-RMR, formerly A-1)

On March 5, 2018, the Office of Academic Standards and Evaluation will release Phase II of the Electronic Record Modification Request (e-RMR) to include the following e-RMR: Credit by Examination, One Credit by Department, Exempt Course, Waive Credit, Waive Grade, Exceed Maximum Credit Limitation and Waive Residency.

The first module, "Course Substitution," comprising about 75% of e-RMR submitted by faculty advisors, was released in October 2017. Phase III, the final phase of e-RMR implementation, will be released sometime in late Fall 2018. Feedback from department chairs and faculty advisors on this electronic module has been very positive, particularly with respect to expeditious processing of e-RMR and official notification to students of e-RMR approval.

The e-RMR is a collaborative effort that is ongoing. Special thanks and appreciation to the Office of the Registrar, the faculty and staff who have embraced the new module and to Elkin Urrea and Deira Pereyra of the Information Technology Division, whose ideas, technical knowledge and support is instrumental to the project's success.
