The CUNY Policy on Sexual Misconduct is posted on the College Policies page of the Lehman website at <http://www.lehman.edu/academics/policies.php>). Haven for Employees is an online program with information on the prevention of sexual misconduct including sexual harassment, stalking, domestic violence, dating violence and sexual assault. Haven presents information through audio and written text and guides you through scenarios to help you understand how to respond to different situations. You will learn about relevant laws, CUNY/Lehman policies and procedures, and the on and off campus resources that are available to you. Haven takes about 45 minutes to complete and can be completed in more than one session. To access the program follow these instructions:
