Residencies include Yaddo, LMCC, The Studio Museum in Harlem, and Sharpe-Walentas. Her work has been featured in Artforum, The New York Times, Flash Art, Interview, The New Yorker, and Voque. In 2019, Casteel will present a solo exhibition at the Denver Art Museum.
