**Dramatic Escape** transports viewers into the lives of a group of maximum security prisoners who are attempting to mount a behind-bars stage production of *A Few Good Men* at Sing Sing Correctional Facility in upstate New York. Personal stories and candid accounts of the crimes that landed them in prison are interwoven with everyday struggles and philosophical considerations of the nature of redemption. Through creative expression, the RTA program provides the opportunity to learn social and cognitive skills that act as a springboard to education, family reconciliation, and ultimately, successful re-integration into community life.
