CUNYfirst is Live! - HR, General Ledger, Line Item Budgeting, Course Catalog

• Working in HCM - Human Capital Management

With school starting soon and staff returning for the Fall term, it's a busy, busy time in our Human Resources offices. In addition to continuing to adopt and use the new HR tools in CUNYfirst, our teams are working toward mastering the applications they are using to hire and administer all of our personnel records.

This week, HR teams took part in a workshop focused on the Chancellor's Report. A check of transactions processed in CUNYfirst showed that there are continuing questions on how to define some of the HR actions for an employee's status. This session allowed the HR community to share their experiences and support each other to help create an accurate and complete Chancellor's Report, which will be created for the first time in CUNYfirst in September.

The next step for using the new tools comes soon as colleges will begin working creating, posting and hiring open positions in the new recruiting tool – the Talent Acquisition Management (TAM) module. We'll work through that process a few campuses at a time so we can learn the issues associated with its usage.

Also ahead for HR is the Users Acceptance Testing (UAT) for the next rollout, scheduled to go live in October – Daily Transaction Report, working with Artiba, which is how we publicize position openings, and Mass Salary Update.

• Faculty Workload

The CUNYfirst Core Team will host an online meeting this coming Tuesday, August 25 with the University's Faculty Workload and Institutional Research community to discuss role definitions and upcoming training. The goal is to explain how training will be delivered and their role in that. The Core Team has requested of the Workload Coordinators a list of four individuals at their campus who play a key role in the calculation of faculty workload and report creation. That will begin to help us begin the crucial task of matching individuals to the roles they will perform in the new faculty workload application.

Training

September General Ledger, HCM and Budgeting classes have been added to the Enterprise Learning Management (ELM) system and users should check in to see if classes they need or want have been added to the schedule. Our Training team is beginning to create the classes and schedules for Manager Self Service (MSS). Memos and reminders will be sent soon to invite managers and supervisors for their training at the Borough Training Centers.





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Campus Solutions – Users Acceptance Testing (UAT)

UAT test script writing is proceeding on schedule. We are very thankful at this time of year for the time given by our college Subject Matter Experts who are concentrating on review of drafted scripts. A large portion of the preparatory tasks are proceeding as well with the assistance of graduate students from Baruch's Zicklin School of Business. We are very appreciative of their efforts to help testing move forward at a time when our campuses are gearing up for the new school year. Also, new testing standards were introduced to our team this week to ensure that testing new processes meet CUNY requirements.

Procurement

The CUNYfirst Procurement team this week released its schedule for Conference Room Pilot (CRP) 2 sessions by announcing 24 sessions in the next three months beginning this coming Tuesday, August 25. CRP 2 sessions allow our Oracle partners to explain the various processes to explain how data will be populated and to begin the understanding of the workflow. Our campus Subject Matter Experts in the various topics will receive invitations to the sessions that range in areas from Requisition and Purchase Order processing to Receiving and Inspection of delivered goods.
