Lehman College Hosts 50th Finale Springfest on May 14

BRONX, NY – Lehman College will host 50th Finale Springfest, a community-wide celebration featuring live music and cuisines from around the world, from 3-8 p.m. on Tuesday, May 14.

The conclusion to Lehman’s year-long 50th anniversary commemoration, Springfest will take place on campus at the Athletic Field rain or shine, with free admission. Tickets are required for entry and must be reserved at <https://50thfinalespringfest.eventbrite.com>.

The lineup of musical artists and acts at Springfest covers a spectrum of genres and styles, from well-known, established performers to college-led ensembles. The three headliners are Trinidadian-born soca artist Lyrikal, DJ Self from Power 105.1FM and VH1, and La Orquesta Jeryco, one of New York City’s premier salsa bands.

Also scheduled to perform: Statik Vision Rock Band, MC Vince Brady, DJ Phnx, RHAMpage Step Team of Sigma Phi Rho Fraternity, Lehman College Latin Jazz Ensemble, Lehman College dance ensembles, and more.

“Lehman College’s first-ever Springfest is an invitation to celebrate the wonderful diversity of our community through music and food,” said Tara Tomlinson, director of Advancement Initiatives at Lehman. “For many attendees, this will also be an introduction to our beautiful campus and the college itself, which, we hope, will foster a closer engagement for all of us in the years to come.”

There will be a concession stand with food for sale, along with free hot dogs, popcorn, ice cream, and cotton candy provided by the college. There will also be fun activities for kids and families, including a bouncy house and rock climbing wall.

Springfest attendees will have an opportunity to learn more about Lehman programs as well, with special tables set up for Admissions, Continuing Education and Professional Studies, Campus Life, Lehman L.I.F.E., and Urban Male Leadership Program.

Lehman College’s 50th Finale Springfest is among the many events happening as part of Bronx Week 2019, the annual borough-wide celebration taking place May 10 through May 19.
