

NON-DEGREE CONTRACT

CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION TO LEHMAN COLLEGE AS A NON-DEGREE GRADUATE STUDENT

Congratulations on your admission to Lehman College as a non-degree student. As a non-degree student, you must abide by the policies set forth in the Lehman College Graduate Bulletin. It is important for you to understand and follow these regulations.

- ▷ Acceptance to the college as a non-degree student does not guarantee future admission to a graduate program of your choice.
- ▷ Non-degree students are not eligible for a degree from Lehman College.
- ▷ Acceptance to the college in non-degree status does not guarantee enrollment in a particular class.
- ▷ As a non-degree student you may enroll in any course at the college contingent upon approval of a graduate advisor and the availability of space in the course.
- ▷ If you apply and are subsequently admitted to a degree program, you may count a maximum of 12 credits earned as a non-degree student toward your degree program, pending your graduate advisor's approval.
- ▷ Students whose cumulative index falls below 3.0 will be placed on academic probation and given one-semester to bring their average back to 3.0. Students whose cumulative index is still below 3.0 at the end of the probationary semester will be officially dropped from the college.
- ▷ If you are submitting academic records from a non-English speaking country, you must demonstrate competency in English through TOEFL scores of at least 500 (higher for most programs). You have one semester in which to satisfy this requirement.
