***The deadline for students to withdraw with a grade of “W” has been extended from April 1st to May 14th, 2020.**

**** Students should consult with their academic and financial aid advisor to confirm if this option will still allow them to count the course towards their major/degree requirements, if credit is earned with a grade of P.**

In order to receive this grade, a student needs to continue participating in academic related activities, complete all assignments, and take the final exam/culminating experience.

If a passing letter grade is earned, the student will receive a grade of ‘P’, credit for the course, and no impact on the GPA. If a failing grade is earned (F), the student will receive a grade of NP and no impact on the GPA.
