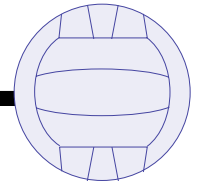

2001 CUNYAC / State Farm Women's Volleyball Championship

HUNTER SWEEPS CCNY FOR SIXTH CONSECUTIVE CROWN

New York, NY – Hunter College defeated CCNY, 30-18, 30-24, 30-27 on its home court to take the championship match of the 2001 CUNY Athletic Conference Women's Volleyball Championship, presented by State Farm. The Hawks (23-10) extended their CUNYAC winning streak to 69 straight matches, dating back to the start of the 1996 season. Hunter will represent the conference in the NCAA Championships, starting November 10th, for the third consecutive time.

Hunter junior Jezel Rodriguez (Bronx, NY) was spectacular, posting with 27 assists, 12 kills and 10 digs in the final, to earn MVP honors. "It feels great to win an individual award," said the three-time all-star and a veteran of eight CUNY Championship games in three sports. "CCNY wanted it as much as we did today. They were fired up for this match. We just had more experience."

Despite the straight set win, it was the most competitive CUNYAC final since 1996, when the Hawks won by a total of six points over three games. The Beavers (16-4), who have only lost a match to one other college this season, have a very young team and an extremely bright future. Their starting rotation features five freshmen, including all-stars Erja Vetterranta (Jarva, Finland), who had eight kills and three aces, and Catherine Martinez (Bronx, NY) who added seven kills and five digs.

"It was a great match," said CCNY head coach Robert Pichardo. "I'm very proud of my team and the season we had. I believe that it's the school's best team since the mid-eighties," continued the 1997 CCNY graduate. "But the credit goes to Lauren and Hunter today."

"This was the best CUNY final I've had," said Hunter head coach Lauren Caiaccia, the CUNYAC Coach of the Year and three-time championship winner. "Robert has done an excellent job building that team. I'm just proud that we rose to the occasion."

Prior to the finale, Hunter had already clinched a berth in the New York State Women's Championships, which will be held this weekend at Oneonta State. The Hawks have also played in that championship after each of the last three seasons.

"I think I am hitting my playing peak. I was a primary hitter. It is a culminating moment of my career," said CUNYAC Player of the Year Nora Wnuk who added 13 kills, and eight digs for Hunter. "I feel encouraged for the postseason after the way our players have improved over the course this year. No matter what, we will play with heart, and close the season with intensity," added Hunter's senior middle hitter from Manhattan.

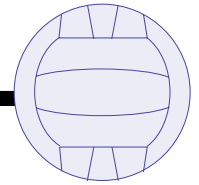

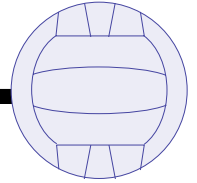

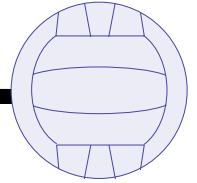

QUARTERFINAL RECAPS

Hunter beat Brooklyn 30-17, 30-8, 30-11.

Number one seed and five-time defending champion Hunter (22-10) got 21 kills from senior middle hitter **Nora Wnuk** (New York, NY / Beacon) while junior setter **Jezel Rodriguez** (Bronx, NY / DeWitt Clinton) added 36 assists. Senior setter **Nicole Berish** (Brooklyn, NY / New Utrecht) led number eight seed Brooklyn (2-18) with 5 digs.

CCNY beat York 30-14, 30-17, 30-10.

Number two seed CCNY (15-3) got 15 kills and 12 digs from freshman outside hitter **Erja Vettenranta** (Jarva, Finland / Jarva) while junior setter **Sheila Garcia** (Bronx, NY / Cardinal Spellman) added 25 assists. Freshman setter **Maria Montenegro** (Jamaica, NY / Sacred Corazon) led number seven seed York (3-13) with 10 digs.

Lehman beat Baruch 30-23, 30-11, 30-20.

Number three seed Lehman (14-7) got 10 kills and 16 digs from junior outside hitter **Madelayne Garcia** (Bronx, NY / J. F. Kennedy) while junior setter **Sakeena Esteves** (Bronx, NY / John F. Kennedy) added 17 assists and 11 digs. Junior middle hitter **Jennifer Quinones** (Brooklyn, NY / Boys & Girls) led number six seed Baruch (4-9) with 9 kills.

John Jay beat Medgar Evers 30-21, 30-26, 30-22.

Number four seed John Jay (15-5) got 26 assists from senior setter **Isorys Dilone** (Brooklyn, NY / Bushwick) while junior outside hitter **Vianca Canuelas** (San Juan, PR / San Juan) added 10 kills. Freshman **Tammy Chase** (Bridgetown, Barbados / Combermere) led number five seed Medgar Evers (12-7) with 9 kills.

SEMIFINAL RESULTS

Hunter beat John Jay 30-15, 30-23, 30-17.

Top seeded Hunter (23-10) qualified for the teams' eighth straight CUNYAC final via 14 kills from senior middle hitter **Nora Wnuk** (New York, NY / Beacon) while senior outside hitter **Jen Manicad** (Flushing, NY / Francis Lewis) added 12 kills. Freshman outside hitter **Mary Onyango** (Bronx, NY / J.F. Kennedy) led John Jay (15-6) with six kills and three blocks.

CCNY beat Lehman 30-17, 34-32, 30-26.

Number two seed CCNY (16-3) won their way into the CUNYAC final for the first time since 1994 with 12 kills and 12 digs from freshman outside hitters **Erja Vettenranta** (Jarva, Finland / Jarva) and **Catherine Martinez** (Bronx, NY / Clinton) with 13 kills and 11 digs. Junior outside hitter **Madelayne Garcia** (Bronx, NY / J. F. Kennedy) led Lehman (14-8) with seven kills.

Hawks Wnuk Honored With Player of the Year

New York, NY - Hunter College's **Nora Wnuk**, a senior who steadily improved throughout her four-year career, was named the 2001 CUNY Athletic Conference Player of the Year. Wnuk has come into her own in her final year, topping CUNY in kills per game (4.17), while hitting at a .277 clip for the year, and collecting 2.42 digs a game. The runner-up for Player of the Year was CCNY's **Erja Vettenranta**, a 26-year old first-year player from Finland, led CUNY in hitting .406, digs 4.60 and service aces, 2.08 per game. Her teammate, **Catherine Martinez** was named Rookie of the Year with 4.02 kills, 4.17 digs and 1.55 aces per game. Alongside Wnuk all year has been three-time all-star **Jezel Rodriguez** (8.3 assists, 1.42 service aces), while Lehman's **Madelayne Garcia** (3.45 kills, 2.16 digs) is the only other repeat all-star on the first team.

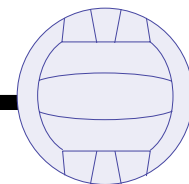

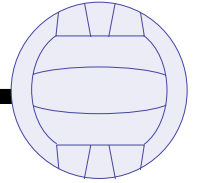

HAWKS FALL IN NCAA FIRST ROUND IN ST. LOUIS

St. Louis, MO - The Hunter College women's volleyball team lost its opening round match in the NCAA Division III Tournament to Bethel College (MN) 30-14, 30-15, 30-18. The event was hosted by Washington University. The Hawks (25-13) committed some costly mistakes in the first set with several receiving and serving errors. After hanging in the contest and trailing 21-13, Hunter dropped nine of the next ten points and thus the opening game, 30-14. CUNY Athletic Conference Coach of the Year Lauren Caiaccia's squad settled down in the second set, trailing just 10-9 after a service ace by senior middle hitter Nora Wnuk. Once again, however, Bethel (25-9) would dominate the latter stages to prevail 30-15 despite several service points from junior setter Jezel Rodriguez. The third set played out similarly although the Hawks put up a significantly better fight. Rodriguez played especially well. Bethel's hitting proved to be too much again however, as the Royals won the final set 30-18 and advanced to a second round meeting against three-time defending national champion Central College (Pella, IA).

"I'm very disappointed," said Caiaccia. "It's disappointing when you come to the NCAA Tournament and don't play up to the level you expect." Rodriguez led the Hawks in the match with 12 assist and 10 digs. Wnuk tallied 9 kills while senior Jennifer Manicad added 11 digs. Hunter advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the third straight year by winning its sixth consecutive CUNYAC championship.
