- 1) Approval of the prior minutes (February 19, 2024)

- 3) Assessment webinars and panel
  - a) The Committee discussed the importance of showcasing assessment efforts in a variety of forums, such as the CTL's (Center for Teaching and Learning at Lehman College) during its April 9th event on higher education and equity, during which Donald Sutherland and Devrim Yavuz organized a panel on assessment. These kinds of events, it was noted would demonstrate to faculty and members of the Lehman College community that their work on assessment could lead to interesting opportunities for scholarly work.
  - b) Related to this last point, the AC reflected on the need to keep an inventory of events at Lehman College since there were a lot of interesting activities going on. Future meetings can be dedicated to formalizing the process.

4) Assessment Budget ideas

The possibility that the Assessment Office could have request a budget from the Provost was raised. The AC agreed that this would promote assessment on campus by building a community around assessment. Some of the ideas mentioned were:

- a) An Assessment Day (potentially with food and a guest speaker from CUNY)
- b) Travel for training purposes (is it realistic in the current climate?)
- c) Retreat for more in-depth training or clinics (event to work together on assessment)

5) AES units survey progress

Donald Sutherland presented a progress report of the survey of AES units. Responses were still being collected.

6) General Education assessment

- a) Devrim Yavuz provided a progress report of gen ed assessment for AY24-25, where he is experimenting with a bottom-up approach. While some programs were collaborating, ways in which more people could be reached were discussed, which led to a discussion for ideas to streamline information, which was left for a future meeting.
