

The Senate Assessment Committee met on April 23 and 2026. Its members unanimously voted to form a General Education Subcommittee for the Academic Year 2026-2027. The description is as follows:

GENERAL EDUCATION ASSESSMENT SUB-COMMITTEE

- a. The sub-committee will report to the Standing Senate Assessment Committee and will be active during the 2026-2027 Academic Year
- b. Membership: Six members as follows: five nominated faculty and academic personnel, including those attached to AES units (we suggest that one to two members be from the LEH working group to ensure communication between the two bodies); one administrator; and one invited member of the Student Government Association
- c. Functions:
 - i. Reviews the 2025-2026 annual General Education Assessment report and recommends an action plan;
 - ii. Reviews past General Education Assessment reports and makes recommendations based on the extent to which the findings of the report have informed campus-wide changes and discussions;
 - iii. Surveys, collects and documents existing general education related activities and information generated by the campus community;
 - iv. Formulate an opinion on the proposed new structure for the administration of general education courses (LEH and pathways) to facilitate the collection of assessment-related information
 - v. Propose a framework and tools for general education assessment
