


Johary Ravaloson

Lawyer, publisher and author, Johary Ravaloson is visiting New York on the occasion of the publication of his award-winning novel, Return to the Enchanted Island in an English translation by Allison Charette. Originally published as Les Larmes d'Ietsé, the novel is a coming-of-age story set amidst the enchanted origin myths of Madagascar, with a distinctly twenty-first-century perspective on the country's place in an ever more connected world.

Ravaloson's other works include *Vol* à *vif* (2016 Prix du livre insulaire and 2017 Prix Ivoire for Francophone African Literature) and *Amour, patrie* et soupe de crabes (2019).

With his wife, the artist Sophie Bazin, Ravaloson is founder of Éditions Dodo Vole, a dynamic publisher since 2006 of new works for diverse audiences in Madagascar and Île de La Réunion.
