1.	TEACH Grant is only available to students who are training to become certified teachers in a high-need subject field (see other side for Lehman College eligible programs) and who plan to teach in low-income (Title 1) schools.

3.	For each year that I wish to receive TEACH Grant funds, I must file a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).

5.	I must have an earned cumulative undergraduate and graduate GPA of at least 3.25 or submit proof of scoring at or above the 75^{th} percentile on a national college admissions test.
6.	Continued eligibility requires that I maintain a cumulative graduate GPA of 3.25 or submit proof of scoring at or above the 75^{th} percentile on a national college admissions test.
7.	I must complete a four (4) year service obligation, at a low income school, within eight (8) years of finishing teacher training.
8.	Upon completion of each year of teaching service, it is my responsibility to submit to the Direct Loan Service Center documentation of such service.
