abio Castillo Vasquez knows what it feels like to have to start over. In 2009, with only two semesters to go in his computer science degree, his green card was approved to immigrate from his home in the Dominican Republic to New York City. "None of my credits transferred, so I had to rebuild from the beginning, which was both discouraging and motivating," he says.

Fortunately, Fabio was surrounded by a community of family and friends who encouraged him to persevere through setbacks in his pursuit of his educational and career goals. This advice was needed when after finally getting his associate's degree in computer information system, he paused his studies to work as a plumbing project manager to support his family. With their support, and the help of Lehman College, he decided to return to school for a bachelor's degree in 2023, which is when he discovered the Continuing Education CompTIA A+ Computer Technician program.

"I immediately saw it as the perfect way to strengthen my technical foundation," says Fabio. "Enrolling in the program allowed me to reconnect with my original career goals and build the skills I needed to move forward in IT."

The CompTIA+ program gave Fabio the hands-on experiences that ultimately allowed him to secure his current position at St. Barnabas Hospital. In-person sessions on how take apart and reassemble a computer, and how to wire an Ethernet cable,

gave him foundational skills that have been crucial in his job as a technical analyst. "What made the program even more meaningful was the instructor, who explained the material clearly and shared life lessons I carry with me today," Fabio says. "He reminded us that it's okay to start from zero, and that even if you accept a pay cut at first, the long-term opportunities will be worth it — advice I now see playing out in my career."

Like so many other program graduates, the CompTIA A+ program gave Fabio the technical foundation and confidence to pursue his long-term career path. Industry recognized CompTIA certifications like recognized CompTIA certifications like A+, Network+, and Security+ position graduates for advancement in the IT and cybersecurity fields whether they have an associate's degree, a bachelors, or are just starting their career journey.

Now Fabio is preparing to apply for a master's program in cyber security so that he can finally achieve his dream of being a security analyst, protecting companies and organizations from modern threats. And while he hopes there are no more "restarts" in his future, he knows that with Lehman College in his corner, anything is possible.

The advice Fabio would give someone else who is just starting their career journey is to "trust the process, use your available resources, and believe that the effort will pay off in the long run, because it truly does."







Student Loan



Tax Credits for **Continuing Education Programs**

NOTICE: Form 1098-T is not used or provided for Lehman non-degree courses provided by Continuing Education. Lehman College Tax-ID is only used by Lehman College Degree Courses.

Lifetime Learning Credit (LLC): This credit applies to tuition and fees to earn a degree or other recognized educational credential to get a job or to improve your job skills. You must file Form 8863 and have your tuition receipt in place of Form 1098-T.

American Opportunity Tax Credit

(AOTC): This credit applies to tuition, fees, and course materials such as books and supplies needed for the course of study. You must file Form 8863 and have your tuition receipt in place of Form 1098-T which is not provided for non-credit courses.

Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit:

Trisha Mahase wasn't just looking for another job; she desired a stable career path or fulfilling profession that would allow her to provide a better life for herself and her family.

Growing up with a mother who was a Certified Nursing Assistant and then taking care of her mom in her final years, she knew that she had the traits of a helper. But it wasn't until she found the Lehman College Continuing Education hybrid CNA program that she saw a real path to making that dream come true.

"CUNY on the Concourse was only a few stops away on the train," says Trisha. "The hybrid in-person and online model really worked with my schedule."

Trisha credits the SCPS team, especially Allied Health Program Coordinator Romardio Hamilton, with their help, which gave her the confidence to return to school as an older student. "They answered all of my questions and were there to support me every step of the way."

Participating in two online days and one in-person

allowed Trisha to balance her schedule as a working parent with two young children. She appreciated the willingness of her instructors to go out of their way to teach to the various age and ability levels in the program. And hands-on opportunities to work with medical simulators like CPR manikins and fellow students allowed her to feel confident when it came time to take her CNA certification exam, which she passed in January of 2025.

"Returning to school as an older student, and a parent, meant that my experience was more complicated—I needed to work harder," Trish explains. "But it also drove me to succeed."

Not content to stop her learning journey, Trisha is now looking to Registered Nursing (RN) and Licensed Practicing Nursing (LPN) programs. Looking back on her experience, Trisha says that she would encourage anyone who is thinking about embarking on their own continuing education journey to start now.

"Don't wait," she says. "Something great is ahead of you. Do it for your family. Do it for yourself." ■



Electrocardiography technicians prepare patients for and administer the EKG. They also assist with Holter monitor and stress testing. These highly sought-after positions offer jobs in a variety of health care settings and labs.



An Enrolled Agent is a tax professional who has earned the privilege of representing taxpayers before the Internal Revenue Service. Ashonda Culcleasure's path to being an entrepreneur started when her work schedule conflicted with her son's medical needs. After being denied a day off to take her son to a doctor's appointment, she walked away from her job at the DMV. She started Fix It With Piggy, a technology repair and STEM education company, and never looked back.

Always looking for more opportunities to network and grow her business, Ashonda joined the Bronx Business Tech Incubator. There she discovered a vibrant and inclusive entrepreneurial community in her own backyard "It felt like everyone was on the same team, even though we all had different businesses," she says.

Ashonda credits the BBTI for providing essential

support in networking, financial literacy, business strategy, and encouragement. "Being a solo entrepreneur is challenging," she admits, "but having advisors and a supportive community change everything." Now, with help from the BBTI team, she is building a curriculum with a team of interns, and working to have Fix It With Piggy certified as an official Career and Technical Education program.

Reflecting on her journey, Ashonda emphasizes resilience and openness to learning. "Mistakes are essential to success," she shares. "The moment I asked for help, my entire business changed. Everyone needs a support system." Her advice to future entrepreneurs? "Believe in your ideas, lean into your community, and don't hesitate to seek support. If I can do it, anyone can."

Before discovering Lehman College, Adrian Crawford was working a dead-end job in retail. He knew that he needed to go back to college to jump-start a new career, but as an older student his options felt limited. "I'll be honest, I was a little bit hesitant at first, and a little bit scared," says Adrian.

At the encouragement of friends who had graduated from Lehman, he decided to apply to Lehman through the Adult Degree Program. "My advisors in the program were so very supportive. They answered all my questions, but more than that... they believed in me, were invested in me and what I was able to do."

Never one to pursue a traditional path, with the help of his advisors Adrian decided to combine his passions for business, film and television, and fiction writing into a degree through the BLIS (Bachelor of Arts or Sciences in Liberal and Interdisciplinary Studies) program. This allowed him to follow his own interests and create an educational experience that would support his goals and help him make his dream into a reality.

When asked about his experience with his team of academic counselors and advisors, Adrian has only three words: Positive, positive, positive. And for other older students who are thinking about going to college for the first time to get their degree?

"Don't doubt yourself at all. I was in that same position of doubting myself and thinking I'm too old to be in college. You're never too old to go to college, and it's always going to be a great experience in your life. And with Lehman, you're always going to have that support system — no matter what."



Carman Hall entrance from on campus, across from baseball field: Go down outside concrete stairs and through glass doors (basement level). Make sharp left turn (do not go through grey flipper doors) and continue upstairs. Carman 128 (on 1st floor level) is to the right at top of stairs.

Carman Hall entrance from Goulden Avenue, near Gate 2: Go down ramp to the left. Enter through glass doors to the basement level and go straight through flipper doors to the end of hall and through next set of grey flipper doors. Go up the stairs on the right. Carman 128 (on 1st floor level) is to the right.
