



Master of Science in Counselor Education: Clinical Mental Health

The program prepares students to work in varied environments, such as private practice, substance misuse counseling, not-for-profits, community-based organizations, business, and healthcare. It provides opportunities for high-quality, accessible, and affordable graduate education in mental health counseling for residents in the Bronx and surrounding areas. Graduates can pursue the NYS licensure for LMHC upon graduation.

Admissions Requirements

- Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended
- Bachelor's or master's degree, or foreign equivalent from an accredited school
- Minimum gpa of 3.0
- Two letters of recommendation evaluating potential as a clinical mental health counselor from college faculty, community mental health personnel, or supervisor
- 1,000-word (two specific essay prompts provided in online application)
- Group interview process (for qualifying candidates)
- Current professional resume
