- Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended
- Bachelor's degree or foreign equivalent from an accredited school
- Minimum undergraduate gpa of B
- Two letters of recommendation: A) one must be from a current supervisor
 at the applicant's place of employment who can best evaluate the
 applicant's leadership potential; B) one must be from either a faculty
 member from prior studies or a supervisor who can evaluate the applicant's
 potential for success as a graduate student and work ethic.
- 500-word essay discussing: A) Why the applicant believes the Lehman MSOL is the right program for them. B) description of current (or most recent) role at work. C) describe some of the challenges faced at work
- Current professional resume: detailing all professional employment and community or professional organization leadership positions, memberships, and service
- Currently working or holding a substantial leadership role in a community or service-related organization
- Applicants who satisfy the preliminary admissions requirements will be invited to a group interview with the MSOL program coordinator

Program Requirements

The MSOL is a fully online program that can be completed in approximately 12 months and is offered in two formats:

- Synchronous (online): Students engage in weekly class meetings using a web conferencing platform such as Zoom. Limited class lessons and materials may also be delivered asynchronously.
- Asynchronous (online): Students learn from instruction that is not delivered in real-time or does not occur
 during a specific day or time. Students still are provided with many opportunities to interact wit the
 instructor through the course management system, e-mail exchanges, online discussion forums and
 synchronous methods such as web conferencing. Students also actively engage with other cohort
 members through online discussions, group projects, and presentations.
