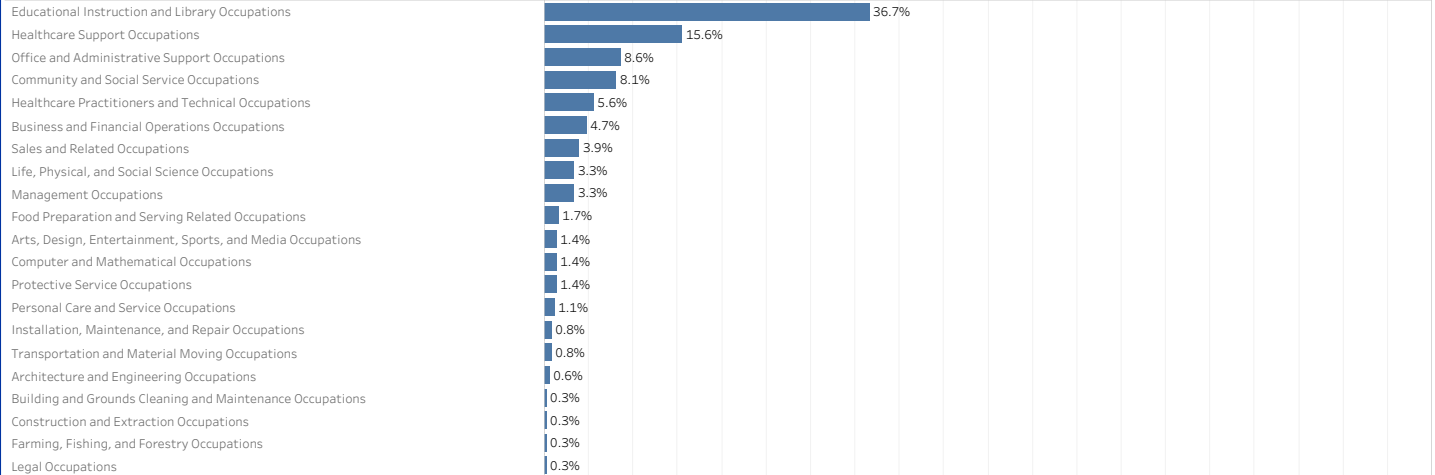

Which job category best represents the work that you do?



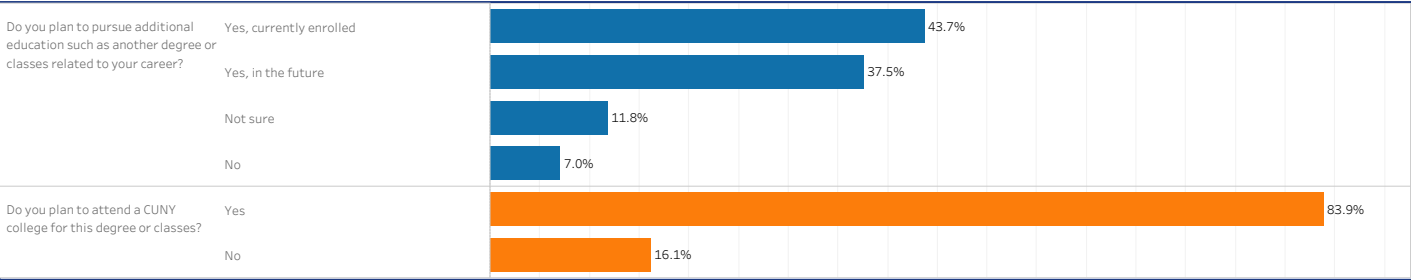
