The following graduate courses may be taken in place of these undergraduate courses: REC 702 (in place of REC 422), REC 706 (in place of REC 361), REC 680 (in place of REC 240), and REC 680 (in place of any other 300-level elective). The student must receive permission from both the academic undergraduate and graduate advisors.
